The first resident was the painter Ferdinand Bol, one of Rembrandt's most famous pupils.

In the 19th century the Van Loon family came to live in the house. The last resident of the house, before it became a museum, was Thora van Loon - Egidius. She was Dame du Palais of Queen Wilhelmina for forty years, and as such invited important royal guests to the house.

The interior and exterior have remained practically intact. Today they form a fascinating historical monument, Museum Van Loon.
