The three gilded herrings. Herbert Dapper had this house built in 1575. He made his fortune in fishing from Skåne, Sweden.

The lower floors of the house in renaissance style were designed rather sober. As we look up we find sandstone layers, classic pillars and lots of little details. The gable is a mix of a stepped gable and a raised neck gable.

A toy museum was located here in 1932 and currently the house is used as officespace for the adjacent Deventer history and toy museum.
